**Subject: CNS OJT Instructors.**

Sir,

CHQ vide letter No. A.12024/1/2011-EC (NR) dated 27/05/2011 has sent the Sr. Assistant (Elex.) trainees for 4 weeks OJT to their respective stations of posting. **There are no designated CNS OJT instructors in any of the stations**

As per AAI Hqr Orders for Proficiency Scheme 7<sup>th</sup> February 1998 and subsequent "Revision of CATC Instructors & OJT Instructors Allowance" letter No. A.60011/17/2000/PP dated 01/12/2006 provision for having OJT Instructors in the CNS discipline is available. It is most unfortunate that in the safety critical services provided in the Air Navigation Service CNS OJT instructors could not be nominated till date. However, regular trainings are being conducted at RTCs and also at station level without designated OJT instructors, which is against the interest of aviation safety. The purpose and the vision with which provision of OJT instructors was introduced in the CNS discipline are being defeated.

Further, it will not be out of place to mention that as per the Proficiency Scheme for CNS Executives, an executive on transfer to a new station requires conversion from one type of equipment to another, if the same type of equipment is not available in the new station of posting. In this case also it will be much more meaningful if the executive undergoes on-job-training under an OJT instructor in the station before appearing for the conversion test.

It is therefore requested to nominate/ designate OJT instructors on priority in the regions and stations so that proper and meaningful on-job-training can be imparted to the new trainees and executives in the CNS discipline.
