Subject: *Stagnation in the CNS discipline*


Sir,

CNS engineers and executives in the CNS discipline are adversely affected in their career progression due to stagnation, non release of the promotions and non creation of posts for the new facilities being installed/ commissioned. Whenever there is a new facility installed/ commissioned it is most unfortunate that no planning is done for the manpower required in sustaining the facility along with the procurement planning; whereas, creation of posts are being done continuously for the users and supporting staff only. The stagnation and severe discrimination in the career growth in comparison to other disciplines in AAI, including supporting staff, is conspicuous in the organization.

We appreciate to know that AAI management is planning to remove stagnation in the CNS discipline with some supernumerary figure to remove the career discrimination in the CNS discipline with the other disciplines in the organization. It is therefore requested that removal of stagnation may be considered at all levels from the posts of Jr Executives to General Managers to maintain a proper hierarchal structure for better functioning in CNS discipline.
